Studio Art (4 credits):

Studio-based class such as drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, photography, or design.

ARH 411: Critical Approaches to Art History Study (4 graded credits)

Required for art history majors; Open to Juniors and Seniors only. Formerly ARH 300

Lower-Division Art History Surveys (16 graded credits):

100-200 level courses, including ARH 314 & ARH 315

Upper-Division Lectures and Seminars (32 graded credits):

300- and 400-level courses, with the exception of ARH 314 & 315

Level requirement: Of the eight required upper-division courses, at least four must be taken at the 400-level.

Distribution requirement: Of the eight upper-division courses, two courses must be taken in any three of the following four chronological breadth areas (24 credits):

(1) Ancient (2) Medieval (3) Early Modern (4) Modern/Contemporary

Elective requirement: The remaining two upper-division courses are electives and may be taken in any area.

Residency requirement: of the eight required upper-division courses, at least four must be taken in residence at UO.
