Issue 1: Major/Minor requirements

- Motion to modify the present language as follows (change in *italics*):
“Students on the MA-PhD track may petition to waive some course work requirements to more quickly progress through the program. A maximum of 36 transfer credits may be granted for equivalent graduate-level coursework taken outside of the UO. *Regardless of the number of transfer credits granted, however, all PhD students are required to take a minimum of 12 credits in their major area and 8 credits in their minor area after matriculating into the UO’s HA&A graduate program.*”
- Discussion: purpose of the change -- provide more flexibility for students to satisfy major/minor requirements once they are in HAA program
- DGS moves to vote on new language – approved unanimously.

Issue 2: 600-level departmental requirements

- How to apply transfer credit to our 600-level departmental requirement to the MA-PhD track?
- DGS - Motion to modify requirements: *Language from MA-PhD students states: students are required to take 12 credits of graduate seminar including 611. We’d apply this same language to the BA-PhD track students and to the MA students – approved unanimously.*
- Spring faculty meeting: Will resume discussion on possible long-term changes to 600-level courses. Issues/ideas: maintaining enrollment in 600-level courses; two-term long 600-level course (team-taught); 600-level course as “studio.”
- Implemented beginning AY22-23: 600-courses stable day/time
